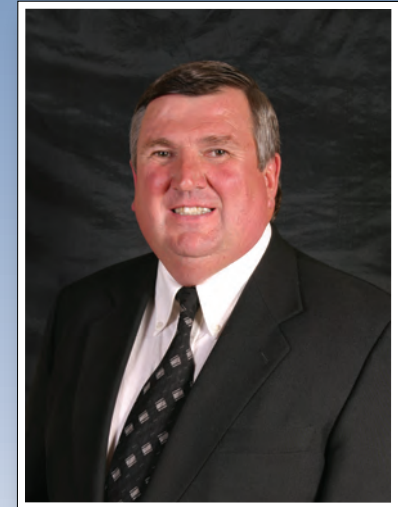

I am proud of my 19 years of municipal political experience in the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville (WS) and The Regional Municipality of York including:

- Six years service as Town of WS ward councillor (1991-1997)
- 13 years as Mayor and CEO of Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville
- Chair of all WS Council, Committees and public planning meetings
- 13 years as member of York Regional Council including Chair of the Region's Transportation Committee and member of the Finance and Administration Committee

During the past four years, we have worked together and accomplished many things, including:

- New Fire Station 51 with 24/7 firefighters and ambulance service
- New and upgraded sports and recreational facilities including Clippers Sports Complex, Bethesda Park, Rupert Park and Memorial Park, new tennis courts in Ballantrae and 130+ acre park in Musselman's Lake
- Support of local arts and culture including the new arts and entertainment centre (Nineteen on the Park), and additional funding for enhancing Latcham Art Gallery and a new museum and visitor/community centre in Vandorf
- Annual Mayor's community events including the local Food Drive, New Year's Family Celebrations and Golf Tournament. To date, the Annual Golf Tournament has raised more than \$250,000 for local youth and community projects
- Downtown revitalization and expansion projects including a weekly farmers market
- Leash-free dog park
- New comprehensive zoning by-law
- New Public Works Operation Centre
- Implementation of municipal-wide green bin program for waste diversion



We must continue to work together. New and upcoming projects include:

- Development of the new town office
- New seniors facility and a centre for the youth
- Implementation of town-wide neighbourhood and road watch program
- Enhancement to current skateboard park and lawn bowling facility
- Identify sites for a new indoor soccer and curling facility
- Library expansion
- Completion of four lanes along Stouffville Road to Hwy 404 and the reconstruction of the Ninth Line to Markham Stouffville Hospital for more efficient traffic flow
- Memorial Park re-design plan
